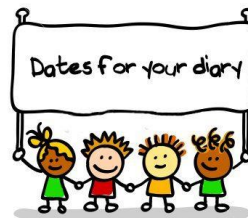

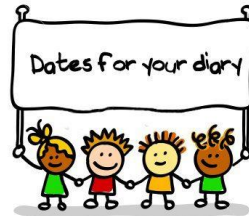

#### Food

Tinned meat, custard, tinned fruit, instant coffee, tinned rice pudding, jam/marmalade, jars of pasta sauce, tinned vegetables, rice, tinned spaghetti, tinned tomatoes, tinned fish, quick cook meals e.g. noodles, rice & pasta, UHT milk, pasta, soup, beans, cereal

#### Toiletries

Toile roll, soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shower gel, sanitary products

#### Also collected

Dog food, cat food, nappies (large size 5 or 6 most helpful), baby wipes, household cleaning items and washing powder

#### And any spare strong, clean bags

They cannot accept out of date/opened/damaged food, home grown or home made produce, formula milk, baby food, medicines or alcohol, toys, electrical goods, clothing, furniture or any non food items except toiletries or cleaning products.
