IMPORTANT - Safety information

We would like to share a quick safety reminder regarding silica gel packets. These small packets are often found inside new bags, coats, shoes, and other packaged items to help keep them dry during storage and transport.

While they are clearly labelled "Do Not Eat," they can sometimes be overlooked when children bring new items into school. The packets may present a choking hazard if handled by young children.

We kindly ask that you please check any new bags, coats, lunchboxes, or other items your child brings into school and ensure that any silica gel packets are removed and disposed of safely at home.
